II. Purpose and Legal Basis

The processing of personal data is necessary for the performance of a contract, as well as for taking steps at the request of the data subject before entering into a contract, in accordance with Article 6(1)(b) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (GDPR). These purposes include administration, organization, and participation in mentoring activities carried out within the InnovPrecMed project.

Personal data processed for the purpose of contacting participants of mentoring activities within the InnovPrecMed project are processed on the basis of the legitimate interest of MENDELU in accordance with Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR.

The purposes of processing include, in particular:

- contacting and identifying mentoring participants by MENDELU or project partners;
- evaluating applications and assigning a suitable mentor;
- organizational and administrative management of mentoring activities;
- control activities, internal process management, and project reporting related to the implementation of the InnovPrecMed project.

III. Personal Data

Personal data may be made available to authorized employees of the Controller and to project partners involved in the implementation of the InnovPrecMed project, only to the extent necessary for database management, mentor assignment, communication, mentoring or placement implementation, and project management and reporting.

The categories of personal data are:

- role of the mentoring participant;
- institution of the mentoring participant.
